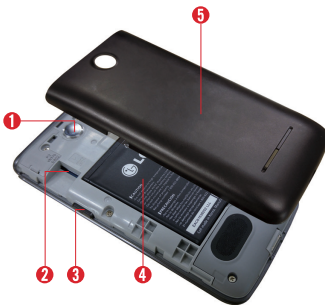

Setting Up Your Phone

Step 1. Remove the Back Cover

Place your fingernail in the USB/charger port and pop the cover off the phone.

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Setting Up Your Phone

Step 2. Insert the Battery

Insert the battery, making sure to align the gold contacts. Press down gently to secure the battery.



Optional: Insert the microSD Card

If you have a microSD card, slide the microSD card into the microSD card slot with the gold contacts facing down.

NOTE: The microSD card is sold separately.

Step 3. Replace the Back Cover

Place the back cover over the back of the phone and then press down along the edges to secure the cover.



Step 4. Charge Your Phone

Before turning on your phone, charge it fully.

Using Your Phone

Turning Your Phone On/Off

To turn your phone on or off, press and hold the **PWR/END** Key.

Setting Up Voice Mail

1. Dial *86 and press **SEND**.
2. When you hear a greeting, press **#** to interrupt.
3. Follow the setup instructions.

Checking Voice Mail

From your phone:

1. Dial *86 and press **SEND**.
2. Follow the instructions.

From other phones:

1. Dial your wireless number.
2. When you hear the greeting, press **#** to interrupt.
3. Follow the instructions.

NOTE: Voice mailboxes not set up within 45 days will be canceled. Your voice mailbox is not password protected until you create a password by following the setup instructions.

Backup AssistantSM

Backup Assistant is a free Verizon service that can save your phone's address book to a secure website. If your phone is lost or damaged, or if you upgrade to a new phone, you'll be able to restore your contacts. You can change your Backup Assistant settings in **MENU > Contacts > Backup Assistant**.
