Make, End, and Answer Calls

- 1 From the home screen, enter a number and press .

Tip: Press **Delete** to delete the last number.
Press and hold **Delete** to erase all numbers.
Press **Store** to add the number to your Phonebook.



- 2 To end a call, press .

- 3 To answer a call, press .

Tip: To answer a call by pressing any key, go to **Menu > Settings > In-Call Setup > Answer Options** and set **Multi-key** to **On**.

Add Contacts to Your Phonebook

- 1 From the home screen, press . Scroll to **Phonebook**, then press .
- 2 Scroll to **New Entry**, then press .
- 3 Scroll to **Phone Number**, then press .



- 4 For each field, press **Change**, enter the information, then press **Ok**.
- 5 When you are finished, press **Done**.





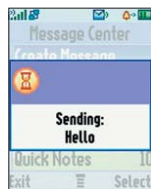

Send a Text Message

- 1 From the home screen, press . Scroll to **Messages**, then press .
- 2 Scroll to **Create Message**, then press .
- 3 Scroll to **New Short Msg**, then press .



- 4 Enter your message, then press **Send To**.
- 5 Select the recipient for your message, then press **Send**.

Text Messaging Tips

1 To add your own quick note (text that you send frequently), press **[Menu]** > **Messages** > **Quick Notes** > **New Quick Note**, then enter your quick note and press **Ok**.



2 To send a message saved in Drafts, press **[Menu]** > **Messages** > **Drafts**, select the draft message, press **Send To**, select the recipients, and then press **Send**.

Pair (Link) Bluetooth® Headset

- 1 From the home screen, press **Menu**, then select **Settings > Connection > Bluetooth Link > Setup**.



- 2 Scroll to **Power**, then scroll right to turn the power **On**.

When the Bluetooth feature is turned on, you can pair the headset with your phone. Once the headset and phone are paired, you do not need to repeat the following steps.



- 3 On the headset, press and hold the Call button until the light turns on and remains steadily lit. If the light is flashing or does not remain steadily lit, make sure the headset is fully charged and repeat this step.

Note: If your headset has a folding microphone, quickly unfold the microphone as soon as the light is steadily lit.

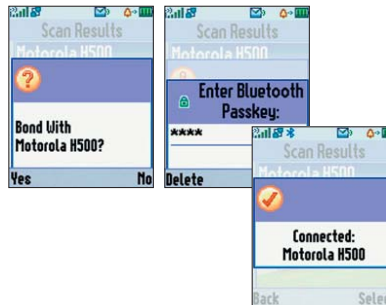


- 4 On your phone, press **Back**, then select **Handsfree > Look for Devices**.



- 5 Scroll to the headset and press **Enter**. Press **Yes** when prompted to bond.

Enter the passkey **0000** and press **Ok**. When pairing is successful, the headset light changes from steadily lit to flashing and the Bluetooth icon appears in the top status bar on the phone.



- 6 To test the pairing connection, put the headset on and make a call. If your phone and headset are successfully paired, you will hear ringing. To save battery life, keep your headset turned off when not in use.



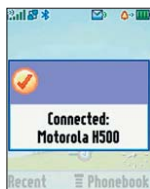

Autoconnect Bluetooth Headset

- 1 After you pair (link) your headset and phone, you can set up your phone to automatically connect to the headset when you turn the headset on. From the home screen, press , then select **Settings > Connection > Bluetooth Link > Device history**.
- 2 Scroll to the headset and press .
- 3 Scroll to **Access**, scroll right to change it to **Automatic**, and press **Done**.



- 4 To use your headset, turn the headset power on. To disconnect your phone from the headset, turn the headset power off.

Adding a Datebook Event

- 1 From the home screen, press . Scroll to **Tools** and press .



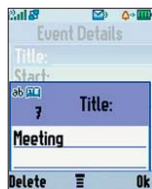
- 2 Scroll to **Datebook** and press .



- 3 Scroll to the day you want to schedule an event and press , then scroll to **New** and press .



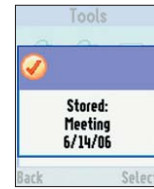
- 4 Enter a title for the event and press **Ok**.



- 5 Scroll to other fields to enter information such as: start time, event duration, event date, repeat the event, and set an alarm for the event.



- 6 Press **Done** to store the new event.

Set Ring Styles

- 1 From the home screen, press . Scroll to **Ring Styles** and press .
- 2 Scroll to **Style** and press . Select a ring style and press .
- 3 Once a ring style is set, scroll to **Detail** for the Ring Style and press . Select a sound and press to set the sounds for different events such as calls, messages, voicemail messages, alarms, etc.
